Grasses

- *Cynodon dactylon* (Bermuda Grass)
- *Tridens flavus* (Purpletop)

Forbs

- *Cyperus lancastricensis* (Sedge)
- *Eupatorium serotina* (Late-flowering Throughwort)
- *Gnaphalium obtusifolium* (Sweet Everlasting)
- *Aster vimineus* (Small White Aster)
- *Solidago altissima* (Goldenrod)
- *Solanum carolinense* (Horse Nettle)
- *Mentha piperita* (Peppermint)

Shrubs and Trees

- *Pinus taeda* (Loblolly Pine)
- *Juniperus virginiana* (Eastern Redcedar)
- *Rubus* sp. (Blackberry)
- *Gleditsia triacanthos* (Honey Locust)
- *Liquidambar styraciflua* (Sweetgum)

Stay to the left, cross the stream bed (usually dry), and take the trail on the right to the old field. The old field looks out over the horse fields.
